Night Owls - Season 2018-19

The Season

- Teams will play a 17 week season
- Eligible teams will also be asked to participate in the Tuesday v Thursday Night challenge on Tuesday 19 March 2019

Tuesdays

- 8 weeks from 23 October 2018 to 11 December 2018
- No play on 18 & 25 December 2018 and 1 & 8 January 2019
- 9 weeks from 15 January 2019 to 12 March 2019

Thursdays

- 8 weeks from 25 October 2018 to 13 December 2018
- No play on 20 & 27 December 2018 and 3 & 10 January 2019
- 9 weeks from 17 January 2019 to 14 March 2019

Finals Nights – All Teams Involved

Tuesdays

- On 26 February, 5 & 12 March 2019, **all teams** will play on these finals nights. Essentially all teams are placed in a group of at least 8 and play off in these finals nights. The top 8 will contest the Night Owls "Premiership" title (week 1, 1v8, 2v7, 3v6, 4v5 - week 2 highest rank winners v lowest rank winners - week 3 Grand Final is the winners of week 2). Teams in the remaining groups will play off for the Nights Owls "Championship" & "Excellenza" titles.

Thursdays

- On 28 February, 7 @ 14 March 2019, **all teams** will play on these finals nights. Essentially all teams are placed in a group of at least 8 and play off in these finals nights. The top 8 will contest the Night Owls "Premiership" title. (week 1, 1v8, 2v7, 3v6, 4v5 - week 2 highest rank winners v lowest rank winners - week 3 Grand Final being the winners of week 2). Teams in the remaining groups will play off for the Nights Owls "Championship" & "Excellenza" titles.

Inclement Weather/Extreme Heat

- If games on 26 & 28 February 2019 and/or 5 & 7 March 2019 are not live, the winners will be determined on the higher finishing team on the premiership table.
- If games on 12 or 14 March 2019 are not live, the Night Owls title will be determined via the highest placed team on the premiership table who are scheduled to or competing in the grand finals

Tuesday/Thursday Night Challenge Match

- The Tuesday v Thursday night challenge match will be held on Tuesday 19 March 2019. Essentially the top 13 teams from each night will be asked to participate. More details to follow.

Smoking

- For Night Owls, smoking is now **prohibited in the south eastern corner** of the venue. Smoking is allowed in the designated areas on the northern side of the bowling club.

Fees

- The game cost is \$8.50 per player and we ask that someone from each team collect your fees and pay \$34.00 in exchange for team score card
- Sturt Bowling Club @ Unley Oval does not charge a player registration fee with each players' Bowls SA "Night Owls player administration fee" paid by the Club

General Rules and Conditions of Play

- Games will commence at 7 pm with "chimes" to sound at 9 pm to signify end of play (any end being played when chimes sound can be completed)
- Games will be a maximum of 16 ends
- On 12 & 14 March 2019, the "Premiership" grand final will be granted an extra 10 minutes to complete 16 ends but the end in progress at 9-10 pm will be the last.
- Where scores are tied in any week 1 final, semi-final or grand final, an extra end(s) will be used to determine winner – which may commence after the chimes have sounded.
- Please enter team's player names on the score card
- There will be no dead ends - If the kitty goes out of bounds it is to be placed on the 2 metre mark (or as close as possible) and the game will continue
- Please return scorecards to the designated person and place kitties and mats in the trolley. Rink numbers to be placed in bowls room and scoreboard names (and clips) to be placed on the table in the committee room
- Green Fees will be refunded if games are not completed due to the weather or for some other reason (e.g. power failure)
- Games "are not completed" if, across all rinks, an average of 8 ends are not completed.
- If any team looks to forfeit a game the sub-committee will try to make up the numbers so a team can play. Forfeiting a game is where (i) a team cannot play with 3 players or (ii) a team plays with **ALL** players made up by the sub-committee. In (i), the team not forfeiting will receive points as if their opposition has forfeited. In (ii), the team not forfeiting will receive points as per the result of the game played – see **Scoring**
- Where teams play with 3 players, the leader and 2 bowl 3 bowls and the skipper bowls 2.
- Where multiple forfeits occur, the sub-committee reserves the right to amend the draw so as to accommodate the maximum number of teams participating

Pennant players

- Pennant players are welcome at Sturt Bowling Club Night Owls.
- In balancing the retention of Pennant players in Night Owls and also to assist those not quite yet at that standard, the following conditions apply to Pennant players:
 1. Teams may play pennant players in any position
 2. Teams will receive a 2 shot penalty per Pennant player but this penalty does not extend to temporary or "fill in" Pennant players – there are **no** exemptions for 1st or 2nd year Pennant players except where the 1st year Pennant player is also 1st year Night Owl player.
- Teams are asked to self-regulate these conditions but blue shirts will be available for assistance as required

Scoring

- 10 points for a Win and 5 points for a Draw
- 2 bonus points will be awarded to each team (win or lose) if they do not forfeit the match or otherwise at the discretion of the Sturt Bowling Club Night Owls sub-committee
- Teams who receive a forfeit (and not otherwise play) will be awarded 12 points and a 10-0 result
- Teams who forfeit will receive 0 points and a 0-10 result.
- If a team is **scheduled** a bye, they will be awarded 12 points and a 10-0 result
- Positions on premiership table are determined by "points" then "shot differential" then "shots for". Should this not separate sides at the end of the minor round, the result of the matches between the impacted sides during the minor round will determine order. If this does not determine order, a countback on the most recent match or matches will be used

Inclement Weather Conditions

- An average of at least 8 completed ends must be played for games to be live on a given night (i.e. 104 completed ends over 13 rinks)
- If games on a given night are not live in the minor round, they will be rescheduled except where that round is the last minor round.

Extreme Heat

- Sturt Bowling Club respects the right of individuals and/or teams not to play in extreme heat... and at all times we ask Night Owls to keep themselves adequately hydrated
- Where the forecast **air** temperature **at 3pm** on the day of play **for 730pm is 38 degrees or more**, play will be abandoned www.bom.gov.au/places/sa/adelaide/forecast/detailed
- Team representatives must have the abandonment confirmed by the club before advising team members of same

Final

- Any circumstances not provided for in the above regulations will be decided by the Sturt Bowling Club Night Owls sub-committee or representative on the basis of equity, fairness and the laws that support the sport of Lawn Bowls.
