Example of format of Kangaroo Island 2025 Carnival:

- The format for 2025 included a number of mixed medley games, women's games and men's games utilising the three KI Clubs – Kingscote, Pandana and Burchmore.
- Players drive between them (no shuttle bus). Much like we do here, there is a car pool system between Clubs, so although the Sturt team will need some cars, others would be able to hitch a ride.
- There was a separate 'free' day during the carnival for women and men and there were some planned activities perhaps a lunch and/or dinner.
- Sea Link sponsored the event in 2025 offered travellers 10% discount
